What causes power steering fluid leaks?

Power steering fluid leaks are usually caused by a cracked or worn-out hose that feeds the power steering pump. Also give the hose clamps and other connections a careful inspection.

What should I do if my power steering fluid leaks?

If your power steering fluid is leaking, first check the hoses and clamps for any cracks or wear. If they are in good condition, then inspect the power steering pump next.

Why is my steering wheel hard to turn?

Issue: No Power Steering Assist (Loss of Hydraulic Power) If your steering wheel feels unusually hard to turn, it may take 5 times your normal strength to make a routine turn. This could indicate that the power steering hydraulic assist is losing power. Don't check the fluid level while your car is cold; run it for a few minutes first.

Why is my power steering fluid low?

If your power steering fluid level is low, you'll need to investigate the cause. Possible reasons include cracks in the hydraulic lines, defective components, or a recent accident.

What does power steering fluid smell like?
