Will Akon give electricity to a million people in Africa?

By 2020, Akon Lighting Africa had provided solar energy to 25 nations and about 28.8 million Africans in need. The singer has also expressed his vision of building a futuristic city in Senegal, called Akon City, powered entirely by sustainable energy.
