

Does Akon have solar power in Africa?

Akon's investments include solar power in Africa. In 2014, Akon and co-founders Samba Bathily and Thione Niang launched Akon Lighting Africa with a mission to "bring electricity to African villages by a clean and affordable solar energy solution," according to The Wall Street Journal.

What is Akon Lighting Africa 'Solar Academy'?

Last Summer, the Senegalese-American singer -- in partnership with political activist Thione Niang and entrepreneur Samba Bathily -- launched Akon Lighting Africa initiative's "Solar Academy" to provide an affordable source of electricity to 600 million Africans.

Will Akon give electricity to a million people in Africa?

Senegalese pop-star Akon, in partnership with Give1 Project and Africa Development Solutions Global Corporation, aims to give electricity to one million households in nine West and Central African countries by the end of 2014.

Why is Akon Lighting Africa a non-profit company?

Because of this, he established Akon Lighting Africa as a for-profit company, not a non-profit charity, and it's also why he created the Solektra Solar Academy so that Africans can learn about solar power to become self-sufficient and not require charitable donations.

What did Akon do for Africa?

In just one year, Akon's initiative was a smashing success by providing 14 African nations, including Guinea, Senegal, and Sierra Leone, with sustainable, solar-powered electricity via street lamps and solar panels.

What is Akon doing in Africa with Solektra?

Apart from providing solar lighting and other products, Akon is training workers in solar technology at a school he established in March, in Bamako, Mali. Solektra's African headquarters also are located in there. France's Sunna Design is providing some solar lighting products to Solektra, and also is collaborating on a factory in Mali.
