

What solar incentives are available in Alberta?

Alberta offers a wide range of provincial solar incentives including: On-Farm Solar Program: Designed to reduce carbon emissions in the agricultural sector, this program offers an incentive of up to \$.60 per installed watt up to 25% of project cost, with a \$50,000 or 100kW cap.

Does Alberta have a solar program?

Back in 2016 Alberta launched The Alberta Municipal Solar Program however since available funding is fully allocated and no new applications are no longer being accepted. However various Albertan municipalities offer their own unique solar programs.
