

Does Alberta have a solar farm?

The solar farm will generate carbon offset credits under Alberta's regulated carbon emissions program. On top of purchasing Big Sky Solar, TotalEnergies has signed an agreement with RES to acquire certain wind and solar projects under development in Alberta, for a total renewables power production capacity of more than 800 megawatts (MW).

Is Alberta ready for solar power?
