Why is a 100 watt tube amp Louder Than a solid state amp?

If a 100 watt tube amp is louder than a 100 watt solid-state amp then it means that the tube amp is supplying more power and not actually 100 watts. A watt is a watt is a watt...period. Here's the formula for calculating power: There's no variable for "tube" or "solid state".

Can a tube amp be a solid state amp?

Fortunately for those of us with budgets, technology has come a long way in closing the gap between a great vintage tube amp and a modern solid state amp. The 70's and 80's saw a surge in solid state amplifiers being used for guitar amps. Some would even incorporate tubes into the preamp stage, creating what we call hybrids.

I've had so many amp/preamp combinations through the years. Both solid state and both tubes and any combo within. ... I've used about 372 guitar amps over the years ...
