The 'inverted pyramid' structure is a mainstay of traditional mass media writing. Following this structure, the most fundamental facts appear at the top of the story, in the lead paragraph. Non-essential information appears in the following paragraphs, or 'nut' graphs, in order of importance.

#### What is the inverted pyramid style of writing?

The inverted pyramid style of writing is an essential tool for journalists, marketing professionals, and content creators alike. This particular writing method captures the attention of readers from the beginning by providing key details: who, what, when, where, and how.

#### How do you write an inverted pyramid?

Since Web users and email readers typically scan text, using the inverted pyramid form of writing is a good way to get the most important information in front of your readers -first. Position your main points (who, what, when, where, why and the how) at the beginning of the article, and then go into more detail towards the end of your piece.

#### When was the inverted pyramid style invented?

The inverted pyramid style was invented more than a century ago. Invented more than a century ago, the inverted pyramid style remains the basic formula for news writing (Scanlan, 2003).
