It also makes it more difficult to overwater your plants! If you start seedlings in a solo cup, you should try to transplant to a bigger pot around the time the leaves reach the edges of the cup. This seedling is ready for transfer!

It can be difficult to water solo cup plants often enough as they get bigger. Some growers must water plants multiple times a day either by hand or with a drip feed so they don't dry out. Plant roots get unhappy when constricted and solo cup plants may get rootbound and die.

How often should you water a solo cup plant?

Some growers must water plants multiple times a day either by hand or with a drip feed so they don't dry out. Watering often enough can be difficult as plants grown in solo cups get bigger and their roots get constricted.

The best time to transplant is by using the "water management cycle". If one waters "every other day" or "every 3 days", then wait to transplant. When the cup needs ...
