

How do I dispose of waste in Asheville NC?

Contact the City of Asheville Customer Service Division at 828-251-1122. Residents can take their waste items directly to the Buncombe County Landfill or Transfer Station for disposal. For disposal information call Buncombe County at 828-250-5460. For general Sanitation questions: sanitation@ashevillenc.gov.
