

Does Austin Energy have a solar standard offer?

With extensive rooftop space, abundant sunshine and an innovative electric utility, Austin Energy has a unique opportunity to add megawatts of rooftop solar power to the grid. The Solar Standard Offer program allows commercial property owners to either host solar panels on their rooftops or lease their roof space to third-party solar developers.

Is Austin Energy a solar company?

Austin Energy, not a solar company, is the city-owned electric utility of Austin, Texas. They have issued a press release urging its customers to be wary of phone or door-to-door residential solar salespeople claiming to be utility or city employees.

How much does Austin Energy pay for solar panels?

Austin Energy will compensate System Owners based on the energy their solar panels generate. Rates are set at \$0.1124 per kWh for systems under 1 MW and \$0.0841 per kWh for larger systems and reflect the cost-savings benefits for the utility by contracting with local solar providers.

How will solar power impact Austin Energy?

Solar produces power when generation is needed the most. Combined with the utility's other renewable energy contracts, these resources move Austin Energy closer to 100% carbon-free electric generation by 2035 and to supplying 65% of customer energy needs with renewable energy by 2027.

Why should you buy a solar system in Austin?
