

How do neonatal sea turtles conserve energy?

To conserve energy, neonatal sea turtles likely take advantage of the Gulf Stream. They drift with the current of the North Atlantic Subtropical Gyre, which acts like a giant lazy river, transporting them in a huge circle around the Atlantic.

How does seaweed help baby turtles?

Because the seaweed absorbs a lot of heat from sunlight, water just below the surface of the seaweed tends to be warmer than surrounding water. And if turtles can manage to stay warm, their metabolism kicks in and they start feeding more, and they may grow faster", explains Mansfield.

Can baby sea turtles be tracked by satellite?

Mansfield's team has found a way to fill in the blanks--by tagging and tracking baby turtles via satellite. Baby sea turtles can indeed be tracked by satellite. Where do newly hatched baby sea turtles go?

After hatching, most baby sea turtles leave the continental shelf. Some turtles enter the Sargasso Sea, a calm region in the middle of the North Atlantic Subtropical Gyre where floating Sargassum collects.
