

How do I Charge my Beats Solo 4?

To turn on your Beats Solo 4, press and hold the power button on the left ear cup for 1 second. To charge your Beats Solo 4, plug them into a power source using the included USB-C to USB-C cable. As your Beats Solo 4 charge, the light on the right ear cup pulses red. When your headphones are at least 95 per cent charged, the light turns white.

How do I Use my Beats Solo 4 headphones?

When you're wearing your Beats Solo 4 headphones, you can use controls to play, pause, adjust volume, answer phone calls, use Siri, and more. You can also listen to lossless audio when connected to a supported device. Press and hold the power button on the left earcup for one second.

The power button is easy to miss, but lives on the left ear cup. How do I listen to lossless audio on Beats Solo 4?

You can also listen to lossless audio when connected to a supported device. Press and hold the power button on the left earcup for one second. Beats Solo 4 have a built-in digital-to-analog converter (DAC), so you can listen to lossless audio when your headphones are connected to a device with a USB-C cable or 3.5 mm audio cable.
