

What does GM battery saver active mean?

Many modern GM made vehicles have a battery saver feature. If you are getting a " battery saver active " message, it means that your car or truck has detected that the voltage in the electrical system is less than 11.7 volts. This is over a volt off of the normal system voltage of around 13- 14 volts.

The battery saver active message indicates that a vehicle's battery charge has dropped critically low, triggering a power-saving mode. It is a feature on many modern GM and Chevy vehicles that activates when the battery level falls below a set threshold.

What does battery saver active mean?
