

Are there public charging stations for electric cars?

Yes, there are three levels of public charging stations for electric vehicles. All vehicles can be connected to either a Level 1 or Level 2 charging station, which have the same charging capacity as those you can install at home.

Can You charge a car at a Level 2 charging station?

Yes, you can charge an electric car at a Level 2 charging station. Level 2 charging allows you to charge your car to full capacity overnight and is fairly common, with many stations being free to use.

Most people charge their electric cars at home. However, if you need to visit a public charging station, there are a few key details that will help make the experience hassle-free.

Which fast-charging station will work with my car?

To find a compatible fast-charging station for your car, download the Chargeway app. It uses a color-coded number system to eliminate confusing names. Alternatively, you can identify the type of charging port your car has: CHAdeMO (DC fast charge) or SAE J1772 (AC level 2).
