Owners of 2021 through 2024 model Ford EVs can order the charging adapter from Ford for free between now and June 30, 2024.

If you're installing for a property, I would go with a J1772 EVSE, either made by Tesla or other. All Tesla vehicles come with a J1772 adapter to plug into public J1772 EVSEs, but non-Tesla owners may not carry a Tesla & J1772 adapter to go the other way. As @Genie said, an EVSE will be nicer for the tenant as well.
