Can Ford EVs charge anywhere in Tesla's Supercharger network?

At Ford's invitation, we headed to a nearby Supercharger station to try the process for ourselves. Ultimately, the demonstration had no surprises, but that's actually a good thing.

Owners of 2021 through 2024 model Ford EVs can order the charging adapter from Ford for free between now and June 30, 2024.
