

How do I get a solar power Charizard?

Short of hacking, you can't get a Solar Power Charizard. If you use online battle simulators like Pokemon Showdown, though, Solar Power Charizard will be available as an option. Well, you could get a legitimate Charizard with Solar Power by trading with someone in Japan. There was an event for DW Kanto Starters awhile ago.

Is Charizard a special attacker?

Solar Power provides a Special Attack boost in harsh sunlight, which Max Flare provides, allowing Charizard to dish out massive damage without needing a turn to set up a boosting move. And with Max Airstream on deck too, Charizard can boost its Speed to ensure it attacks first, making it a menace of a Special Attacker.

What is the difference between solar beam & hidden power Charizard?

Solar Beam covers Rock and Water types, as well as hitting Ground types hard. Hidden Power [Rock] covers other Charizards and other Fire types that resist STAB (Same Type Attack Bonus).

How does Charizard work in sword & shield?

Charizard's Hidden Ability Solar Power allows it to deal damage it normally would not be able to given its Base Stats. In Sword & Shield, Max Flare allows it to set up harsh sunlight automatically, and Max Airstream allows it to boost its speed, making Charizard able to set itself up to sweep without needing the support of its team.

Is Solar Beam a good move for Charizard?

Solar Beam is your best coverage move for Charizard. It doesn't take two turns to charge in the sun; instead it activates instantly and gets rid of water, rock, and ground types.

How does Charizard use Dynamaxing?

Thanks to Dynamaxing, Charizard is able to take hits even from attacks it is weak to, and by using Max Flare it's able to put its Hidden Ability, Solar Power, to good use.

I went with Solar Power because I intend to use Charizard Y as a secondary drought user, with Nintetails as my primary drought user, that way if I switch to Charizard after the sun is up I can abuse Solar Power and then mega evolve when the sun runs out and use Roost.

Actually, when the Pokemon mega evolves, it loses its original ability, and for Charizard Y it automatically becomes Drought. You wouldn't get any use out of the solar power, ...

Charizard's ability can be either Solar Power or Blaze; only the latter ability was available in the original game. Solar Power became Charizard's Hidden Ability in Generation V. Complete version [] Charizard's type becomes Fire/Dragon, which is based on similarities to other Dragon-type Pokemon and one of its

Mega Evolutions.

Solar Power in conjunction with Stealth Rock / Life Orb will just deplete Charizard's health too rapidly, resulting in an early death. Expert Belt should suffice; it allows Charizard to feign a Choice item and gives him a slight power increase with super effective moves.

The reason to use Blaze over Solar Power is because some pokemon with Trace can come in and take advantage of Solar Power as you Mega Evolve, which will put you in a bad spot. The attacks on Mega Charizard Y are pretty much the ...

With Solar Power this effectively grants +1 Special Attack and Speed on top of boosting Fire Blast damage by 1.5x, allowing Charizard to muscle through very durable threats. Solar Beam takes ...

Which Charizard ability is better? Blaze is the best choice of ability for this set, as Charizard can OHKO a 176 HP / 0 SpD Golurk with Fire Blast when it is activated. However, if Charizard is ...

However, if Charizard is used on a sun team, Solar Power can replace Blaze to strengthen its attacks. Solar Beam could also be used in such a scenario, replacing Hidden Power Grass.

Charizard also struggles with offensive pokemon because of its straight up awful typing and bad defenses. The only types it resists are Bug, Fire, Grass and Fighting, and with ...

Fireblast/Heatwave Dragon Pulse Solar Beam Air Slash/HP Ground/Sunny Day (This varies on whether you have Sunny Day support or not)
