

What happened at a Tesla charging station in Chicago?

One Tesla charging station in the Chicago area was flooded with dead vehicles after temperatures dropped into the negative double digits. Brandon Welbourne was left stranded in Evergreen Park for hours after he said his Tesla used more battery than it typically does to get to work in the freezing temperatures.

Why can't I Charge my Tesla in Chicago?

These extreme temperatures have been blamed for issues at Tesla Supercharger stations across the city. Fox News reported on a bunch of Tesla vehicles stuck with no power and unable to charge at a Supercharger in Chicago: Tesla owners are reporting not being able to start charging their vehicles once plugged in.

Are public charging stations turning into car graveyards?

Public charging stations have turned into car graveyards over the past couple of days. "Nothing. No juice. Still on zero percent," said Tyler Beard, who has been trying to recharge his Tesla at an Oak Brook Tesla supercharging station since Sunday afternoon. "And this is like three hours being out here after being out here three hours yesterday."

Why are Tesla Superchargers closed in Chicago?

InsideEVs did some investigating of its own, and here's what we found: For starters, several Tesla owners in the Chicago metropolitan area reported via the Tesla Owners Club forum on Monday that three out of 13 Superchargers were closed, possibly due to the frigid weather, mainly in Oak Brook, Rosemont, and Country Club Hills.
