

Are there cheaper energy sources from Cities Skylines 2?

There are for comparison other energy sources from Cities Skylines 2. I've looking on "total cost of MV energy" which in month 0 has only cost for build power plant and in other months are added upkeep per MV. Aren't there cheaper source of power? Yes one source of power is there that is Incineration Plant that's burn garbage and produces 250 MW.

What is the best power plant in Cities Skylines 2?

Best power plant per MV goes to...Nuclear Power Plant. This plant have higher purchase price for one MV which is around 6 667C= but upkeep price is only 1 333C= which is lowest in game. So that mean that you must invest a large into this power plant but you will get cheap energy. You should build only one nuclear power plant in Cities Skylines 2!

You should build only one nuclear power plant in Cities Skylines 2! But this isn't that easy for us because Nuclear Power Plant consumes a lot of water so you need to be prepared that after building you probably need to extend this service which are additional costs. While electricity was transferred by connecting power lines between power plants and electricity "zones" created around buildings in Cities: Skylines, buildings now connect to the electricity grid through either above-ground or underground cables.
