

Does Delmarva Power offer community solar?

Residents in Hartford, Cecil, and more with electricity service from Delmarva Power can take advantage of community solar to save money on electricity. What is community solar? A community solar project is a solar farm whose electricity is shared by more than one property.

How much can I save by joining a Delmarva Community Solar Farm?

Savings differ from program to program, and also vary by month. On average, most community solar subscribers in Delmarva receive a 5-10% discount off of traditional electricity costs over the course of a year.

Where does Delmarva Power operate?

Delmarva Power delivers electricity across 5,400 square miles in Maryland and Delaware covering the Delmarva Peninsula.

How does community solar work in Maryland?

In this case, you receive credits on your electric bill for excess energy produced by your share of a solar garden. Under a seven year community solar pilot program which began in 2017, residents of Maryland are able to access the benefits of virtual net metering by subscribing to community solar.

Can solar energy save you money in Delaware?

Delaware has made it easier to use solar energy through Delmarva Power, which advocates say can save you money. Gov. John Carney on Friday signed Senate Bill 2, which is expected to make it simpler for Delaware residents to use solar energy to power their homes through a new community-centered program scheduled to start next year.

How many megawatts can a solar project power in Delaware?

The bill expands the size limit for the solar projects from two megawatts to four. Four megawatts can power about 1,000 homes and is more economically feasible, though Delaware's utility companies are still trying to figure out if the state's power grid is modernized enough to handle an influx of new energy generators, according to Hansen.
