

Does Walt Disney World have solar panels?

The Walt Disney World Resort currently has two solar arrays, including one shaped like a giant Mickey, that generate a total of 55-megawatts of solar power and provide 10% of the park's energy. The two new solar installations won't be located on park property; they will be built in Gilchrist and Polk Counties, covering more than 1,000 acres.

How will solar energy impact Disney World?

This will mean that 40 percent of Walt Disney World Resort will be produced by solar energy. As the most recent examples of Disney's commitment to taking action to change our planet's story, these new arrays will reduce Disney's carbon footprint and help power even more magic in the Disney Parks, Resorts, and beyond.

How much solar energy does Disney World need?

At its max performance, solar energy will be responsible for 25 percent of Walt Disney World's power needs. The two new solar arrays will be capable of producing more than 375,000 megawatt hours of energy in its first year, which is the equivalent of removing 29,500 vehicles from the road annually.

When will solar power be available at Disney World?

Both are expected to come online by early 2023. By placing the solar facilities elsewhere in Florida, the Walt Disney World Resort will not need to rely on sunny skies in one area for reliable solar energy. The addition will also make Disney World the largest commercial consumer of solar in the state of Florida.

Does Disney have a solar system?

With this expansion, Disney will become one of the largest commercial consumers of solar in the state of Florida. More importantly, it will join the numerous steps that the company has taken to deliver on its 2030 goal of achieving net-zero emissions. Both arrays are expected to be online by early 2023.

Does Disney use geothermal energy?

For example, Disneyland Paris is leveraging geothermal energy to help power its onsite theme parks and resorts. At Castaway Cay in the Bahamas, Disney Cruise Line uses solar power to heat water for our crew on the island. And, at Disney California Adventure, our Radiator Springs Racers attraction is powered by 1,400 solar panels.
