How many EV charging stations are there in California?

California Gov. Gavin Newsom announced last week that there is now one EV charging station for every five gas stations in the state, which is home to more than 39 million people. There are now 105,000 public or shared private electric charging stations in California and 500,000 at-home chargers.

Will California build a public charging station?

California will have to build public charging stations at an unprecedented -- and some experts say unrealistic -- pace to meet the needs of the 7 million electric cars expected on its roads in less than seven years.
