Are brand-name clothes toxic?

It is also for that reason, Wicker said, many lawsuits over toxic chemicals found in brand-name clothing have failed. -Look for brands that use certifications like Oeko-Tex, GOTS, or Bluesign, which indicate that the clothing is free of toxic chemicals.

What happens if you put toxic chemicals on your clothes?

So that has a big role to play in how these toxic chemicals end up on our clothing," Wicker said. Various studies have found exposure to those chemicals can cause anything from skin irritation and respiratory issues to several types of cancer, fetal abnormalities and reduced immune system function. Are all textile chemicals toxic?

While not all chemicals used are necessarily toxic or harmful, the Swedish Chemical Agency found that 10% of the 2,400 textile-related substances studied were a "potential hazard to human health" and 5% were considered a hazard to the environment.

What are toxic substances in clothing?

Chao said that toxic substances come primarily from these sources during the garment-making process: Plasticizers: These are often added to waterproof clothing and make colors appear more vivid. Fluorescent Agents: Light-colored clothes may contain fluorescent agents, added to make them look whiter, more colorful, and brighter.

Are your clothes toxic?

Your clothes' material is a great way of assessing the likelihood of their toxicity. While some fabrics are practically guaranteed to be non-toxic (we'll cover these soon), others are more prone to harmful chemicals. The culprits? Synthetics.

Do fashion brands use toxic chemicals?

Many fashion brands use chemicals in their production, yet with the (minimal) effort to reduce their usage to some extent. However, brands such as Shein, Temu, Ali-express, Zaful, and Forever 21 are notorious for their continued reckless reliance on toxic chemicals.
