

Is Sol beer gluten-free?

Sol is not gluten-free and is made from barley. If you are sensitive to gluten or suffer from any form of Coeliac disease, it is best to avoid Sol beer.

Is Sol gluten-free?

The alcohol content of Sol is 4.4% abv but is only 4.2% abv in the UK. Due to the use of barley in the brewing process, Sol is not gluten-free. However, Sol is vegan friendly as no animal products are used in the brewing process. In this article, I will attempt to fully answer all of the questions raised above.

Is beer gluten-free?

According to the FDA, gluten-free beer must either be inherently gluten-free or not contain an ingredient that is a gluten-containing grain. The gluten content in the beer must be less than 20 parts per million (ppm). Additionally, the FDA allows the use of three equivalent claims to gluten-free: free of gluten, without gluten, and no gluten.

Is Sol a vegan beer?

Yes, Sol is vegan. Unlike English beers such as Hobgoblin or London Pride, Sol does not use isinglass to clarify its beer. This means that there are no animal products used in the brewing of Sol and it can therefore be classified vegan-friendly. What Beer is Similar to Sol?
