

Does Duke Energy offer a solar & battery incentive?

The incentive only applies to new solar AND battery systems. Solar-only and battery-only systems do not qualify. At this time, Duke Energy has not released any equipment eligibility requirements. There are two options in the program: PowerPair and PowerPair +EnergyWise Battery Control. The key differences are:

Does Duke Energy offer solar rebates in North Carolina?

Duke Energy customers in North Carolina will soon have access to rebates worth up to \$9,000 for home solar and battery systems. In May 2024, Duke Energy is opening applications to the PowerPair pilot program that offers a one-time incentive for residential solar and battery installations.

What is Duke Energy powerpair?

Duke Energy is implementing PowerPair, a new incentive-based pilot program for installing home solar generation with battery energy storage in its Duke Energy Carolinas and Duke Energy Progress service areas in North Carolina.

How do I sign up for Duke Energy powerpair program notifications?

With up to \$9,000 in rebates per system, Duke Energy PowerPair program reduces the cost burden of installing solar and battery systems in North Carolina.

What is the North Carolina solar plus battery incentive program?

The company received approval from the North Carolinas Utility Commission (NCUC) for the program on January 11, 2024. The one-time incentive-based program, designed to help make a home solar plus battery system more affordable for customers, offers up to \$9,000 in incentives for residential customers who install a solar plus battery system.
