

What is that Lucky Old Sun in Fallout New Vegas?

"That Lucky Old Sun" is a quest in Fallout: New Vegas that revolves around reactivating the Helios One solar power plant. Your choices in this quest lead to several different outcomes for both you the player, as well as to the region of New Vegas. A few quick tips before I get into the guide: Bring armor-piercing ammo.

Where is HELIOS One located in Fallout New Vegas?

HELIOS One is located in the Mojave Wasteland in Fallout: New Vegas. It was established by Poseidon Energy as a solar power plant to provide power to the Las Vegas Strip and the regional power grid.

What is housed in the power plant of Helios One?

The power plant of HELIOS One houses steam turbines and all of the machines required to transform the energy into usable electricity. Constructed Pre-War by Poseidon Energy, HELIOS One is a concentrated solar energy plant consisting of an enormous array of reflectors and the power plant itself.

What kind of robots guard the solar collection tower?

The solar collection tower is a complicated affair. When the Brotherhood retreated, they enabled the security systems. Military grade robots swarmed the corridors of the tower, including Protectrons, Robobrainz, Mister Gutsies, and/or sentry bots (dependent on the player's level).

Each battery adds 1 more power and they snap into the solar panels. The wall panel has room for 1 battery and the panel rack has room for 2. Enjoy! -RGardin; Original Mod ...
