

What is the Florida Solar Rights Act?

The Florida Solar Rights Act is a property rights act that prevents HOAs and other governing bodies from enforcing rules that would prevent homeowners from installing solar panels. Under this act, HOAs can require approval before solar panels are installed.

Are solar panels legal in Florida?

Florida law forbids ordinances, deed restrictions, covenants, or similar binding agreements from prohibiting solar equipment use.

What are the solar tax incentives in Florida?

Floridians benefit from the federal investment tax credit (ITC) for solar, which allows a solar customer to receive a tax credit of 26% of their contract price in 2020. These laws vary state to state.

Do you need a permit to install solar panels in Florida?

The inspection must be completed before the system is connected to the grid, and any necessary repairs or adjustments must be made before the system can be turned on. Another important aspect of Florida's solar laws is the process of obtaining a permit to install a solar panel system.
