

What is FPL SolarNow?

FPL SolarNow is a community solar program that brings solar power to Florida through hundreds of solar arrays across the state. With the support of dedicated participants, it enables customers to benefit from solar energy without installing panels on their own property.

How does FPL offer solar energy?

What is the FPL solar together program?

The FPL Solar Together program is offered by the Florida Power & Light utility company. Under this program, customers can subscribe to a certain amount of solar energy, with the goal of offsetting up to 45% of their energy usage. The subscription rate is a fixed \$6.76 per month per kilowatt subscribed, with a credit rate of 3 cents per kilowatt.
