Are solar panels really free?

No, solar panels are not free. Advertisers claiming to offer free solar panels typically provide a solar lease or power purchase agreement (PPA). In these arrangements, a company installs solar panels on your house for no upfront cost and charges you a monthly rate for the power they generate.

What is a free solar panel offer?

A "free solar panel" offer doesn't mean you will get solar panels for free. Instead, this usually refers to an agreement that allows you to start using solar panels without incurring upfront costs. However, you will have to make payments in the future.

How do I get free solar panels?

Use social media tools such as Facebook, Twitter, and Myspace to let people know that you're looking for free panels. You never know who people may know and it never hurts to ask. Contact government highway departments and road construction companies to see if they have any damaged solar panels that they're giving away.

Are free solar panels a scam?
