

Are solar panels free?

The Department of Energy is aware of claims of offers for free solar panels or that solar companies must provide solar panels for free if requested. However, the federal government does not offer any programs for free home solar panel installations nor does the government require companies to grant solar panels for free to customers.

Does the federal government offer free solar panels?

The federal government does not provide free solar panels, but does provide incentives that reduce the cost of going solar. You can go solar with no upfront cost by taking out a \$0-down loan, signing a lease or PPA, or subscribing to a community solar farm. Of the no upfront cost solutions, \$0-down loans provide the best long-term savings.

Where can I install solar panels for free?

There are programs that offer free installation of solar panels. For instance, Solar Works DC installs solar systems for free on the homes of low income residents during their training. Energy for All is another program for low-income homeowners in Colorado, California, and Washington D.C. Some government grants are available in Boulder, Colorado.

Are free solar panels a scam?

Many other "free" or "no-cost" solar programs are outright scams. Tax credits and other incentives can reduce the upfront costs of going solar without committing you to unfavorable terms -- just make sure they're legitimate. Can you get free solar panels?

Should you sign up for free solar panels?

Unsolicited leads from door-to-door salespeople: If a salesperson knocks on your door offering free solar panels, don't sign up for anything until you carefully research the company and its products. High upfront costs and hidden fees: Avoid signing a contract for "free" solar panel systems if a high upfront cost is still involved.
