How do I find EV charging stations?

As a general rule, that software can also point you towards EV charging stations. You just have to search for them as you would a gas station or some other landmark. How do I add EV charging stations?

Add EV Charging Stations Zoom in on the map and click on station markers to review details. Ensure compatibility with your vehicle, then click "Add to Trip" to include it. Repeat the process to add additional charging stops.

Costco, Target, and Walmart all have EV charging at fewer than 10 percent of their locations, and many of Electrify America's fast charge stations are located in Walmart lots.
