Do electric companies pay for solar energy?

In certain circumstances, electric companies pay for solar energy produced by their customers if the customers use less energy than they generate from their solar system. Electric companies determine how much power a customer has used over the course of a year.

How much does solar power cost?

The monthly basis will affect how much the electric company pays for solar power. For example, the current up-rate for November is \$.03988 (.40 cents) per kilowatt. If you sell this electricity back to SDGE, they will credit you to your account at .40 cents a kilowatt.
