Does Idaho have solar power?

Currently, less than 3.5% of the state's electricity comes from solar, but SEIA's data indicates that Idaho is starting to live up to its solar potential. The state currently occupies 24th place in the national solar ranking, a substantial rise compared to 37th in 2020. \*SEIA. Idaho Solar.

How many solar projects does Idaho Power own?

Idaho Power has contracts to buy energy from 27 solar projects in Idaho and Oregon. Of these, 21 projects are currently online and represent a combined capacity of 476 megawatts (MW). Projects still under development are scheduled to add 377 MW. Idaho Power does not own or operate these projects.

How much does a solar system cost in Idaho?

The Residential Clean Energy Credit, formerly known as the federal investment tax credit (ITC), can reduce your solar panel system's cost by 30%. Your entire system qualifies for this incentive, including equipment, labor, permitting, and sales tax. The average cost for a 5 kW solar panel system is around \$14,280 in Idaho.

Can you get a solar loan in Idaho?

For some, financing can be the biggest barrier to going solar. Idaho makes it easy with its State Energy Loan Program, which can be used for home energy upgrades including solar panels, insulation, windows, HVAC, and more. The interest rates vary depending on the loan you select, but won't exceed 7%. You can choose from the following options:
