

Does Idaho Power support solar energy?

Idaho Power supports solar energy and fair prices for all. Customers who install their own generation sources -- usually solar, but also wind, hydropower, geothermal or fuel cells -- can offset some or all of their energy needs.

Is it possible to install solar panels in Idaho?

Installing solar panels in Idaho is a great idea. With a solar energy system on your roof, the need for electricity from the power company can be significantly reduced. Solar power in Idaho can offset your electric bill and go solar for less than you think thanks to state solar rebates.

How many solar projects does Idaho Power own?

Idaho Power has contracts to buy energy from 27 solar projects in Idaho and Oregon. Of these, 21 projects are currently online and represent a combined capacity of 476 megawatts (MW). Projects still under development are scheduled to add 377 MW. Idaho Power does not own or operate these projects.

Where does Idaho Power Energy come from?

You can feel good about where your Idaho Power energy comes from. Clean, affordable hydropower is our largest resource, and we are continuing to pursue our goal of providing 100% clean energy by 2045. We operate 17 hydroelectric projects on the Snake River and its tributaries. Together, these projects make up our largest generation source.

What is the Idaho State solar program?

The Idaho State Solar Program is a financial incentive program designed to attract solar installations on commercial and residential buildings. It offers rebates and incentives on a first-come, first-served basis.
