How can I recycle in Lake County?

To recycle in Lake County, place plastic soap containers loose in the Lake County recycling cart. Recycling carts are obtained through the recycling hauler. To have carts delivered, call Lake County Solid Waste at 352-343-3776.

How do I pick up a trash bin in Lake County?

To schedule a trash bin pick-up in Lake County, residents should call their designated hauler or the Lake County Central Solid Waste Facility Office (352-343-3776). A 48-hour notice is required.

What services are included in curbside collection in Lake County?

Residents of unincorporated Lake County have access to curbside collection; which includes garbage collection, bulk pickup, recycling, and yard waste. All Lake County residences have access to the drop-off centers.
