

When is Lorde releasing 'solar power'?

Yesterday, Lorde revealed her upcoming world tour will launch February 2022 in Christchurch, New Zealand. The tour will cover the territories of the UK, Europe, North America, Canada, Australia and New Zealand. In addition, she also unveiled the tracklist and release date for 'Solar Power', which is set to arrive August 20.

What inspired Zane Lowe's 'solar power' song?

Fresh off the release of her comeback single "Solar Power," Lorde spoke with Zane Lowe about the song, its genesis, and its inspirations on Apple Music. "I was on Martha's Vineyard with my good friend, Cazzie, staying at her house. We had just been for a big swim, all day," Lorde recalled of the day she began the song.

Who is Lorde's biggest character on 'solar power'?

Aside from Lorde herself, the biggest character on 'Solar Power' is our planet. The album is a celebration of the natural world, from the musician's insistence that we should "hope the sun will show us the path" on album opener 'The Path' to 'Fallen Fruit's disappointment in past generations leaving today's youth to deal with the climate crisis.

Did Zane Lowe sample cicadas on solar power?

Zane Lowe, a native New Zealander, then told his compatriot that she captured "the sound of a New Zealand Summer." Lorde agreed and said that she also sampled cicadas for "Solar Power." Soon after, Lorde discussed Phoebe Bridgers and Clairo's background vocals on "Solar Power." She said: I love those girls so much. They killed it on the song.

Did Stephen Colbert take a photo on 'solar power'?
