

What is required for solid waste collection in Miami-Dade County?

A permit is required for anyone in the business of solid waste collection or recyclable materials collection, removal or transport for hire or salvage over the streets or public right-of-way in Miami-Dade County. If you witness illegal dumping in progress, call 911.

What does the Miami-Dade County Waste Department do?

It is the mission of Miami-Dade County. The Department is committed to its mission of providing exceptional waste collection, recycling, disposal and mosquito control services that protect, preserve and improve our environment and the quality of life in our community. When will my garbage collection service resume in Miami-Dade?

Service will resume on your following scheduled pickup day. Manual waste collection, where garbage is not collected using automated trucks, is provided to a limited number of households in Miami-Dade's waste collection service areas. A limited number of customers receive twice weekly community container garbage collection (dumpster) service.

Which cities offer curbside recycling services in Miami-Dade County?

The following cities in Miami-Dade County offer curbside recycling services: El Portal, Florida City, Medley, Miami Beach, Miami Springs, North Bay Village, South Miami, Virginia Gardens, and West Miami. Waste collection is provided twice each week and recycling every other week.

Where can I report illegal dumping in Miami-Dade County?

Report problems such as illegal dumping and missed garbage or recycling pickups. Permitted haulers can deliver garbage and trash to the waste-to-energy facility, where it is turned into refuse derived fuel (RDF). Miami-Dade County residents can safely dispose of home chemical products at Home Chemical Collection Center locations.

What can be recycled in Miami-Dade County?

Miami-Dade County's curbside recycling program has made it easier for residents to recycle right: What can be recycled: Numbers on plastics are no longer helpful indicators of recyclability. Miami-Dade County recycles plastic bottle containers regardless of the number listed. What can't be recycled: Batteries: dry cell batteries, lead acid batteries.
