Does Georgia Power offer EV rebates?

Georgia Power's commercial customers can get rebates on Level 2 EV chargers installed between January 1 and December 31, 2023. Each commercial customer is entitled to a \$500 rebate per charger with a maximum of 5 chargers allowed. Also, check out the Alabama EV Home Charger Rebate.

Does Georgia Power offer a tou rate incentive?

Georgia Power offers a TOU rate incentive to residential customers who own electric vehicles. To qualify, customers must have a smart meter capable of measuring EV charging usage separately. Georgia Power helps commercial customers in installing charging stations which help to develop infrastructure for various vehicles.

Can you get a tax credit for EV charging in Georgia?

When purchasing, leasing or installing an approved EV charging station in Georgia, a qualifying business can claim an income tax credit. A 10% income tax credit is provided for the costs of converting automobiles to natural gas, electricity, propane or hydrogen with a maximum credit of \$2,500 per vehicle.

How much does an electric vehicle license cost?
