

Does Quebec have a solar incentive?

We've scored Quebec 4/20 for this section. The largest solar incentive in the Quebec was the RenoVert Tax Credit, however, this has expired. Note that all provinces have access to the Federal Greener Homes Rebate of up to \$5,000. This could reduce the cost of a 8.45kW system from \$25,604 to \$20,604.

What solar incentives are available in Canada?

Below is an updated breakdown of available solar incentives across Canada as of February 2025: 1. : Homeowners can receive a grant of \$1,000 per kilowatt (kW) of installed solar photovoltaic (PV) capacity, up to a maximum of \$5,000.
