How do you salvage a wreck in EVE Online?

Salvaging is one of the many professions available to the players of EVE Online, through which a pilot can attempt to recover potentially valuable components from any salvagable wreck of destroyed ships or structures. In order to salvage these components, a Salvager module or Salvaging Dronesneed to be used on the wreck.

Can You salvage a ship in EVE Online?

Salvaging in EVE Online can be a lucrative career or just a good way to get some quick ISK. With a Salvager fitted to your ship, you can attempt to salvage usable parts from wrecked ships in space. Using these salvaged parts, you can manufacture rigs. What is a good ship for Salvaging? What else can I do to improve my salvaging?

What is salvage in PvE?

Salvaging is a good secondary income sourcewhen doing PvE combat, as NPC wrecks can drop valuable modules or items, and their salvage is used to manufacture rigs. Salvaging is easy to train into, reasonably safe, and a good way for newer characters to participate in higher-level PvE content (e.g. locust fleets). Overview symbols for wrecks.

How do I salvage from a wrecked ship?

To salvage from a wrecked ship, you need to have the Salvaging skilltrained to at least level 1, and you need to have a Salvager fitted on your ship. The Salvaging skill has the following prerequisites: Each level of the Salvaging skill increases the chance of a successful salvage per cycle of your Salvager module.

How do you salvage a nullsec block?

The advice about salvaging can actually work with very little investment: How to salvage efficiently as part of a nullsec block: You join a big nullsec block, get a destroyer or exploration frigate (they get a bonus for salvaging modules), fit it for salvaging and put 2-3 MTUs in it's hold. Then go to their ratting systems.

How do I improve the salvaging chance of salvage drones?

There are no other ways of improving the salvaging chance of salvage drones. A beginner salvaging pilot with Salvaging III, fits her ship with a single Salvager I module and tries to salvage a small basic wreck. The base chance to salvage a small basic wreck is 30%, and her skills and module give her a bonus of 3 *5% = 15%.

Salvaging these missions takes less than half the time to run them in the first place, so it's actually a really good ISK/hour return by salvaging when you can. Plus it offers a way to ...
