Does Minnesota offer solar rebates?

Yes, Minnesota offers solar rebates for homeowners who install solar panels. The cost of going solar in Minnesota is roughly \$28,800 for the average 8 kilowatt (kW) system or \$3.60 per watt.

What are the best solar panel incentives in Minnesota?

One of the best solar panel incentives in Minnesota is net metering. If you connect your solar panel system to the grid, you earn credits when you send excess electricity from your solar panels to the grid.

What is the federal income tax credit for solar panels in Minnesota?

When you file your federal income taxes, you can claim a 30% credit towards your federal tax bill for installing a solar panel system. The average cost for a 5 kW solar panel system is around \$15,535 in Minnesota, which comes down to \$10,875 after the credit.
