Andhra Pradesh, with support from central and state governments, offers various subsidies to encourage the adoption of rooftop solar systems. How a solar power project will be regulated in Andhra Pradesh?

The government will encourage solar power producers to set up Solar Power Projects for captive use within the State or third party sale within and outside the State of Andhra Pradesh. These projects will also qualify for Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) subject to applicable regulations/ guidelines issued by the appropriate commission.

How many solar power plants are there in Andhra Pradesh?

Andhra Pradesh has 5 massive utility-scale solar plants with a total capacity of 4160 MW. Out of these, Kurnool Ultra Mega Solar Park (1000 MW) and NP Kunta Ultra Mega Solar Park (978.5 MW) are among India's largest solar power plants.

What is Andhra Pradesh's solar policy?

In 2018, Andhra Pradesh launched its solar policy with the following objectives: Aim for a minimum total solar power capacity addition of 5,000 MW in the next five years to meet the state's growing power demand in an environmentally sustainable manner.

How much does a solar unit subsidy cost in Andhra Pradesh?

At the time of registration, the interested households should pay Rs. 50 as application fee. However, the actual cost of the solar power units is rupees 60000 that will be given to the households for rupees 10000 for their help. Here is the complete eligibility criteria for a solar unit subsidy in Andhra Pradesh state under AP Surya Shakti Yojana:-
