

Are free solar panels a scam?

Know that "free" or "no cost" solar panel offers are scams. The federal government does not install solar systems in homes for free. Are solar panels free?

The Department of Energy is aware of claims of offers for free solar panels or that solar companies must provide solar panels for free if requested. However, the federal government does not offer any programs for free home solar panel installations nor does the government require companies to grant solar panels for free to customers.

While there are some government-funded solar programs for households that qualify, "going solar" isn't free. Honest businesses will tell you exactly how much it'll cost to get and install solar panels. Here's how to steer clear of the scams.

Is the US government giving away free solar panels?

The US government is not giving away free solar panels or paying people to go solar, no matter how many random YouTube and Facebook ads say otherwise. This scam is usually a misrepresentation of the Residential Clean Energy Credit (aka solar tax credit). While this is a great incentive, it can hardly be considered "free solar panels." Here's why:
