Can you get a low income solar rebate in NSW?

In NSW, eligible household can choose to forego their Low Income Household Rebate- valued at \$285 a year - in exchange for a 3kW solar system. While that is a relatively small solar system, the Australian Government states that it could save households \$600 per year, which is more than twice the rebate.

How do I apply for a NSW solar rebate?

To apply for NSW solar rebates: Confirm eligibility for programs like SRES, PDRS, or Empowering Homes. Prepare documentation, including income proof and property ownership. Submit your application via Service NSW or the NSW Government energy website, where you can also track the status of your rebate application.

Are there any solar incentives in NSW?
