

Are there solar rebates in Arizona?

There are no statewide Arizona solar rebates, but it does have the AZ solar tax credit. Arizona's tax credit is equal to 25% of system costs up to \$1,000, and it reduces your state income tax liability. There may be local energy efficiency rebates and financial incentive programs available to you.

Does Arizona have a solar tax credit?

Arizona's state tax credit equals 25% of solar power system costs, up to \$1,000. Most solar installations will earn the maximum \$1,000 incentive. Are solar batteries tax deductible in Arizona?

There is no statewide solar battery rebate or incentive in Arizona. However, energy storage systems qualify for the 30% federal tax credit as long as the battery has a capacity rating of at least 3 kWh. A battery like the Tesla Powerwall 3 costs about \$16,000 when fully installed, earning it a tax credit of \$4,800!
