What does Lorde say when the heat comes?

"But when the heat comes/ Something takes a hold." Lorde revels in the environment throughout the album, whether she's suggesting jumping off Bulli Point on her home country's Lake Taupo on album closer 'Oceanic Feeling' or looking to the skies for answers on 'The Path'.

What makes solar power different from 'Pure Heroine' and 'melodrama'?

'Solar Power' reflects Lorde pulling from Earth not just lyrically, but musically too. Where 'Pure Heroine' and 'Melodrama' were filled with euphoric synths and crisp digital sounds, this album peels away all our technological advances and relies on more organic sounds.
