

How does solar power work in Pokemon Go?

Solar Power (Japanese: ????? Sun Power) is an Ability introduced in Generation IV. During harsh sunlight, Solar Power increases the Poké#233;mon's Special Attack by 1.5x, but the Poké#233;mon loses 1/8 of its maximum HP at the end of each turn, if harsh sunlight does not end that turn. Solar Power has no effect outside of battle.

What happens to a Poké#233;mon with Solar Power in sunlight?

Solar Power: During sunshine, the Poké#233;mon's Special Attack raises to 1.5 times but HP decreases by 1/8th the maximum HP every turn. Chlorophyll: When sunny, the Poké#233;mon's Speed doubles. Early Bird: Sleep conditions lasts for half as long, rounding down.

How does the Solar Power ability work?

In harsh sunlight, Solar Power raises the ability-bearer's Special Attack by 50% but also causes it to lose 1/8 of its maximum HP after each turn. Boosts Sp. Atk in sunshine, but HP decreases.

How does solar power work in Poké#233;mon Super Mystery Dungeon?

The Poké#233;mon loses 3HP every 9-10 turns, but does not prevent the natural HP recovery. In Poké#233;mon Super Mystery Dungeon, Solar Power sharply boosts the Poké#233;mon's Special Attack when the weather is sunny or in harsh sunlight. The Poké#233;mon also loses 1 HP every 10 turns and is unable to recover HP naturally.

What happens to the Poké#233;mon's HP in sunshine?

In sunshine, Sp. Atk is boosted but HP decreases. Boosts the Sp. Atk stat in sunny weather, but HP decreases. During harsh sunlight, Solar Power raises the ability-bearer's Special Attack by 50%, but it also loses 1/8 of its maximum HP after each turn.

Does solar power increase special attack?

For Generation III and IV games, ignore Hidden Abilities. In Explorers of Time, Darkness and Sky, Solar Power increases the Poké#233;mon's Special Attack by one stage in sunny weather. The Poké#233;mon loses 3HP every 9-10 turns, but does not prevent the natural HP recovery.

Pok&#233;mon with the Solar Power Ability have their Special Attack raised but HP lowered Pok&#233;mon with the Orichalcum Pulse Ability have their Attack stat boosted. Pok&#233;mon with the Protosynthesis Ability have their highest stat ...

Solar Power: During sunshine, the Pok&#233;mon's Special Attack raises to 1.5 times but HP decreases every turn. The sheer power this ability grants is staggering. You end up with about as much Special Attack as Mega Mewtwo X. ...

Solar Power: is somewhat of an oddball ability, but again, it relies on sunlight support. Tropius gets a 50% Special Attack boost but loses 1/8th of its HP per turn when sunlight is active. Tropius gets a 50% Special Attack boost but ...

Diamond / Pearl Platinum HeartGold / SoulSilver: Boosts Sp. Atk, but lowers HP in sunshine. Black / White Black 2 / White 2: In sunshine, Sp. Atk is boosted but HP decreases. X / Y O by / A.Sapphire: Boosts the Sp. Atk stat in sunny weather, but HP decreases.

Abilities: Dry Skin - Sand Veil - Solar Power (Hidden Ability): Dry Skin: HP is restored when hit by Water-type moves or when it is raining but also makes the Pok&#233;mon weak to Fire-type moves and reduces HP during strong sunlight. ...
