How are solar energy ETF issuers ranked?

ETF issuers who have ETFs with exposure to Solar Energy are ranked on certain investment-related metrics, including estimated revenue, 3-month fund flows, 3-month return, AUM, average ETF expenses and average dividend yields. The metric calculations are based on U.S.-listed Solar Energy ETFs and every Solar Energy ETF has one issuer.

What is the best solar ETF?

1. Invesco Solar ETF(TAN) The ETF's top 3 holdings are First Solar, SolarEdge, and Enphase Energy. It also has several Chinese manufacturers in its top 10 holdings. 20% of the ETF is invested in utilities and 74% in IT/industrial +manufacturers/sellers of solar systems.

Which green energy ETF should you invest in?

First Trust NASDAQ Clean Edge Green Energy Index Fund (QCLN) This renewable energy ETF is investing in solar stocks but also utilities, EVs, and lithium mining. This is a better choice for investors looking for wider exposure to green energies as a whole. The top 3 holdings include solar companies Enphase Energy and First Solar.
