Solar weapons include armaments for various combat conditions, from primary auto rifles to heavy-hitting rocket launchers. Guardians use solar shotguns in close-quarters battles, precision solar sniper rifles in long-range combat, and deadly fire rocket barrages to exploit opponent weaknesses.

What are the best solar weapons in Destiny 2?

What makes a good solar weapon in PvE?

Weapons that scorch, ignite, or have strong area-of-effect capabilities are particularly valuable. In short, a good Solar weapon in PvE should be able to handle multiple enemies at once while also boosting your overall damage output.

Are solar weapons good for PvP?

A Solar weapon is good for PvP if it has perks that improve accuracy, handling, and damage, especially in high-pressure situations. Look for perks that help you win duels, like Tap the Trigger for better accuracy or Incandescent to spread damage to nearby enemies. Fast time-to-kill (TTK), good range, and stability are key.

Are solar weapons good against other players?

The ability to deal continuous damage over time (DoT) with certain Solar perks also makes them perfect against other players (much depends on your playstyle in this case). D2 TFS Solar weapons often come with perks that amplify their effectiveness.

Are solar weapons still available in Destiny 2?

With this in mind, certain weapons like the Calus Mini-Tool, although still fantastic, have been removed, and only the best available and currently craftable Solar weapons in Destiny 2 have been kept for the sake of convenience.
