Solo cups aren't microwave friendly because they aren't designed to withstand much heat. When you try to pour a hot beverage in a Solo cup, the plastic starts to weaken, becoming soft and pliable. It's safest to keep Solo cups away from the microwave.

Are polypropylene containers microwave safe?

For Polypropylene (PP) containers, a triangle-like symbol with a "#5" sign shows that such a container is made of polypropylene. Hence, it is seen as a microwave-safe plastic container. Before you put a plastic container in the microwave, ensure you check to see if it has the microwave-safe symbol.

On the other hand, plastic containers that are labeled "microwave safe" are generally considered fine to use in the microwave.
